A special meeting of the Stokesdale Town Council was held in the Town Hall at 8416 US Highway 158 on March 27, 2007. The purpose of the meeting was to hold an executive session.

The following members of Council were present: Mayor Pro Tem John W. Flynt, Mickie Halbhook, Fred Berry and Bobby Richardson. Mayor Randle L. Jones arrived at a point latter in the meeting.

Others present included William B. Trevorrow, Town Attorney, and Carolyn Joyner, Town Clerk.

The Special Meeting was held for the purpose of holding a closed session to consider employment contract proposals for an operator of the Town Water system. Council, in open session, considered participation in the publication of a community map.

Mayor Pro Tem Flynt called the meeting to order tat 6:05PM.

Mr. Shelton made a motion to go into executive session for discussion of water issues. Mr. Richardson seconded the point. All Council members present voted aye.

Council returned to open session at 7:35pm.

Mayor Jones indicated that Tammy Welborn had contacted him about the map project and he had suggested that the budget committee should look at the request and if it has merit, then it could be included in the next budget. The Clerk noted that the order must be placed by April 15 and if payment is made with the order, a 5% discount will be given on the order. Mayor Jones made a motion for Council not to purchase the maps. Mr. Flynt seconded the motion. All Council members present voted aye and the motion carried.

The Clerk mentioned that after the Stokesdale Youth Football Association had provided information regarding grants for parks, she had contacted Kathy White, the State representative for the PARTF grant. Ms. White felt that the State would have to apply for the funds and not the Town but she was not aware of any Federal grant monies that were currently available. Ms. White had suggested that if the Town is going to be applying for the PARTF grant, she would like to set a tentative date to come out and walk the property and discuss the steps that the Town needs to take apply for the grant. She suggested coming out on May 3 at 10:00am.

Mr. Flynt noted that Dwayne Crawford has resigned from the Summerfield Town Council.

Mr. Trevorrow noted that he has made plans to visit his first grandchild that was recently born in Alaska and he would not be available for the next Council meeting. He noted that there is a special use permit request that is scheduled for the April meeting. Mayor Jones asked if he would outline the information regarding the special use permit for Council. Mr. Flynt noted that his brother owns the adjacent property and that he would like to be excused from the case. Mr. Trevorrow asked if he had any financial interest. Mr. Flynt indicated that he did not but that he feared that may not be objective in the matter. Mr. Trevorrow suggested that Council should vote to excuse him from the case.

ADJOURNMENT: Mr. Flynt made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Richardson seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 7:38 PM.
