

**TOWN OF STOKESDALE**  
**Special Council Meeting**  
8325 Angel Pardue Road  
Stokesdale, NC 27357

A special meeting of the Stokesdale Town Council was held on Wednesday, May 4, 2011 at the Town Hall at 8325 Angel Pardue Road.

Mayor Jones called the meeting to order at 8:36 am.

The following Council members were present: Mayor Randle L. Jones, Mickie Halbbrook, Bobby H. Richardson, and Cheryl Steele. Councilman James Attaway was absent.

Others present included: Town Clerk/Finance Officer Carolyn Joyner.

Mayor Jones announced that the purpose of the meeting was to deal with change orders for issues pertaining to the ongoing construction projects.


Ms. Joyner suggested dealing with the change orders pertaining to Town Hall be considered first. Change Order #8 for Rip Rap Stone per DENR was required before a CO (Certificate of Occupancy) would be issued for Town Hall. Mr. Carter with R. P. Murray, Inc. had the rip rap installed so that the stormwater drainage basins could be removed. The cost was \$3,235.00.

The second item was a bronze plaque for Town Hall. Corum Signs had quoted the bronze plaque and the interior signage for Town Hall such as the identification for areas such as the mechanical room and the Mayor's office. There was a \$2,000 allowance in the contract for signs. Ms. Joyner said that the total quote was for \$3,190.10. A change order for \$1,190.10 would be necessary to cover the bronze plaque. If both change orders were taken from the Contingency, a balance of \$14,503.36 would remain in the fund. Mayor Jones asked if Mr. Trevorrow's name could be included on the plaque. Ms. Joyner said that she thought it could be added to it.

Mayor Jones said that the change order for rip rap was beyond our control and there are funds in Contingency that can be used for the plaque and it is appropriate and traditional in a municipal building. Mayor Jones made a motion to adopt the change orders as stated by the Town Clerk and as set forth in documents before Council this morning. Mr. Richardson seconded the motion. All Council members present voted aye and the change order #8 and #9 were approved.

The Clerk noted that the only change order necessary for the Park is for addition stone to be placed in the southwest corner beyond the soccer fields that is needed to stabilize a ditch line in the sediment basin. The engineers have looked at this area. Stewart Cooper Newell has reviewed the proposals recommend approval. DENR has not released all of the storm drainage basins. The cost of the change order is \$3,575.00. Ms. Joyner noted that the five and six inch rains that had occurred when grading and seeding of the areas had not been good. Mayor Jones said that there is still some reseeding and plugging that needs to be done and Mr. Spalding will not be mowing these areas as much so that the grass can take hold to get a good stand of grass. Mayor Jones made a motion to adopt the change order for the Town Park that is needed for the southwest corner in order to meet DENR requirements and to deal with the runoff. Ms. Halbbrook seconded the motion. All Council members voted aye and the motion carried.

**ADJOURNMENT:** Mayor Jones made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Steele seconded the motion. All Council Members present voted aye and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:45 am.
